In the following section my personal and professional experiences which I believe have relevance to the role of Director on the Baseball Queensland Board of Management are outlined.

Grants and fellowships

I have a strong track record of seeking and obtaining competitive funding. I have been awarded over \$13.3M of competitive research funding, the majority coming from nationally and internationally competitive granting schemes such as the National Health and Medical Research Council (Australia) and the Canadian Institutes of Health Research. With my expertise in seeking grant funding, I have supported the submission of several grants to external organisations (e.g. Harvey Norman) to support further development of female participation in baseball. I have more recently supported the submission of two grants to the Women Leaders in Sport program, 2023.

I have an exemplary record of developing high-quality written publications for students, professionals and government. I have published over 150 peer-reviewed research publications in the leading international critical care and nursing journals. I am the author of 13 book chapters and several government reports. I have thrice edited *Critical Care Nursing*, a leading international textbook published by Elsevier.

Supervision and Leadership

<u>I have well-developed leadership skills.</u> As evidence of my ability to supervise and mentor others, I have supervised 25 Research Higher Degree students to completion and have mentored 10 postdoctoral researchers during the first 5 years following completion of their PhD. I am currently leading the development of a bespoke, world first Postdoctoral Research Leadership Program which will be made commercially available in 2025. Under my leadership, Baseball Queensland now has a dynamic and productive Equity, Diversity and Inclusion Advisory Council which is working towards achieving key goals which relate to the Baseball Queensland Strategic Plan and the Australian Sports Commission Reconciliation Action Plan.

I have acted as an external promotions advisor for 12 international academics (Canada, China, Jordan, United States) seeking promotion to Professor. This requires me to understand and apply specific criteria against demonstrated candidate outcomes and use a high level of critical analysis and benchmarking to provide high-quality recommendations to Universities. This skill set is useful as a Board Director where we may be required to assist with key volunteer and paid employment opportunities. My experience ensures that this process is fair and equitable.

I have held several leadership positions within the University and Health service. At Gold Coast Health I am the current Chair of the GCH Research Grants Scheme, Chair of the Person and Family Centred Care Research Collaborative, and a member of Research Council (was Chair 2018,2019). At Griffith University I am a member of the Professoriate and the Area of Strategic Investment in Nursing as well as being the Research Higher Degree convenor since 2019.

Professionally, I am a Life Member of the Australian College of Critical Care Nurses and the current Editor-in-Chief of *Australian Critical Care*, the leading critical care nursing journal internationally. In this role I am responsible for leading an Editorial Committee of 9 Editors and an Editorial Board of 25members to drive future direction of the journal and benchmark its ongoing success against agreed KPIs and performance of competing journals.
